2023 GLOWLAND WINTER FESTIVAL

JOIN US

Due to the enormous success of the inaugural event, GLOWLAND 2023 will kick off November 20th and run through January 2, 2024. The 2023 winter extravaganza will include additional light art installations, live music, parades and happenings in and around Oakland's Business District, while providing interactive family fun entertainment for all.

GLOWLAND's signature installation will be presented by the internationally recognized artist team, Lucion Media. They will install *EXPosure*, a participative installation, composed of 3 self-inflated vinyl spheres, ranging from 8' to 15' feet diameter. By moving a light source in front of their faces, visitors generate a creative, artistic, living projection of themselves. Faces become a brush to play with the light and their self-image.
